Consequently, the suit and applications are decreed in accordance with the Consent Terms/Memorandum of Settlement dated 11th September, 2017, a copy of which is marked as Ex. C-1. Registry is directed to prepare a decree sheet accordingly.

Registry is also directed to issue to an authorised representative of the plaintiff a certificate authorizing him/her to receive back from the Collector half the amount of the Court fee paid by it in the present suit.
