ORDER

1. Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.138/2013 registered under Sections 498A/406/34 IPC at PS Uttam Nagar. It is stated that the matter has been settled amicably with the complainant / respondent No.2 before the Mediation Centre, Tis Hazari Courts, Delhi vide settlement agreement dated 02.03.2016.

2. Complainant / respondent No.2 is present with counsel and has been identified by the Investigating Officer. I have enquired from the complainant if she has settled the dispute with the petitioner amicably

without any fear or pressure. She has informed that all the disputes between the parties have been resolved amicably with her free consent and they are living together since December, 2016. She has no objection to the quashing of the FIR in question. She was specifically enquired to wait for some more period to avoid any possible harassment after quashing of the FIR. She again prayed to quash the FIR.

3. The petition is supported by affidavits of the parties. Since the dispute between the parties has been settled and the complainant is residing with the petitioner in the matrimonial home happily, no useful purpose will be served to continue with the proceedings. In the interest of justice and to enable the parties to maintain their matrimonial relations, FIR No.138/2013 registered under Sections 498A/406/34 IPC at PS Uttam Nagar and all the proceedings arising therefrom are quashed.

4. The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
