(1) Present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been preferred by the petitioners for quashing of FIR No.370/2013 registered under Section 498-A IPC at Police Station Dabri, New Delhi. It is stated that the matter has been settled with the complainant/victim amicably.

(2) Respondent No.2-complainant is present before the Court and has been identified by the IO. I have enquired from the complainant whether the matter has been settled with the petitioners amicably without fear and pressure. She has informed that the matter has been settled without any fear or pressure and she has no objection to the quashing of the FIR. Pursuant to the settlement, the marriage between the parties has been dissolved on 4th October, 2016.

(3) The petition is supported by the affidavits of the parties. Settlement/Compromise deed dated 10th February, 2016 signed by the parties is on record.

(4) Since the complainant/Respondent No.2 has voluntarily settled the dispute with the petitioners, no useful purpose will be served to continue with the proceedings. In the interest of justice and to put an end to the litigation and to enable the parties to settle in life after divorce, FIR No.370/2013 under Section 498-A IPC registered at Police Station Dabri, New Delhi and all the proceedings emanating therefrom are quashed.

(5) The petition is disposed of accordingly.
