ORDER

1. Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.444/2014 registered under Sections 307/323/341/34 IPC at PS Krishna Nagar. It is stated that the matter has been settled amicably with the complainant / respondent No.2 vide settlement agreement dated 01.06.2014.

2. Complainant / respondent No.2 is present in person and has been identified by the Investigating Officer. I have enquired from the complainant if she has settled the dispute with the petitioners amicably without any fear or pressure. She has informed that all the

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disputes between the parties have been resolved amicably with her free consent and she has no objection to the quashing of the FIR in question. Pursuant to the settlement of both FIRs (FIR No.444/2014 & FIR No.699/2014), remaining amount of ₹2 lacs by way of demand drafts (of ₹1 lac each) bearing Nos.907514 dated 20.02.2017 drawn on State Bank of India and 500972 dated 27.02.2017 drawn on ICICI Bank has been given to the complainant in the Court today; copies of which have been placed on record.

3. The petition is supported by affidavits of the parties. Copy of settlement agreement dated 01.06.2014 has been placed on record. Learned APP informs that the nature of injuries sustained by the victim is 'simple' in nature. It is further informed that it is a matrimonial dispute and FIR No.699/2014 registered under Sections 406/498A/34 IPC at PS Badarpur has been quashed. Since the dispute between the parties has been settled, no useful purpose will be served to continue with the proceedings. In the interest of justice and to enable the parties to put an end to the litigation, FIR No.444/2014 registered under Sections 307/323/341/34 IPC at PS Krishna Nagar and all the proceedings arising therefrom are quashed.

4. The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
