CRL.M.C. 1690/2017

1. Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.476/2013 registered under Sections 498A/406/34 IPC at PS Gandhi Nagar, Delhi. It is stated that the matter has been settled amicably with the complainant / respondent No.2.
2. Complainant / respondent No.2 is present with her counsel and

has been identified by the Investigating Officer. I have enquired from the complainant if she has settled the dispute with the petitioners amicably without any fear or pressure. She has informed that all the disputes between the parties have been resolved amicably with her free consent and she has no objection to the quashing of the FIR in question. Divorce has taken place vide divorce deed dated 18.10.2016. Pursuant to the settlement, remaining amount of ₹50,000/- by way of demand draft bearing No.496449 dated 05.04.2017 drawn on The Shamrao Vithal Co-op. Bank Ltd. has been given to the complainant in the Court today.

3. The petition is supported by affidavits of the parties. Copy of divorce deed dated 18.10.2016 has been placed on record. Since the dispute between the parties has been settled, no useful purpose will be served to continue with the proceedings. In the interest of justice and to enable the parties to settle in life after divorce, FIR No.476/2013 registered under Sections 498A/406/34 IPC at PS Gandhi Nagar, Delhi and all the proceedings arising therefrom are quashed.

4. The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
