1. This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.409/2016 registered under Sections 498A/406/354/377/34 IPC and Section 4 Dowry Prohibition Act at Police Station Khajuri Khas. It is stated that the matter has been settled amicably and the petitioner No.1 and Respondent No.2 are living together happily in the matrimonial home for the last about eight months.

2. Respondent No.2/ Complainant is present before the Court and is identified by the Investigating Officer. I have enquired from her whether the matter has been settled with the petitioners amicably without fear and pressure. She has stated that the matter has been settled without any fear or pressure and she is living happily in the matrimonial home for the last about eight months.

3. The petition is supported by the affidavit of the parties.
4. Since the matter has been settled between the parties and the complainant is residing with petitioner No.1 in the matrimonial home happily, no useful purpose will be served to continue with the proceedings. In the interest of justice and to enable the parties to maintain their matrimonial relations, FIR No.409/2016 registered under Sections 498A/406/354/377/34 IPC and Section 4 Dowry Prohibition Act at Police Station Khajuri Khas. and all the proceedings arising therefrom are quashed.
5. The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
