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24.04.2017

(1) Present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been preferred by the petitioners for quashing of FIR No.290/2013 under Sections 498-A/406/34 IPC registered at Police Station Burari. It is stated that the matter has been settled with the complainant/victim amicably before Mediation Centre, Tis Hazari Courts.

(2) Respondent No.2-complainant is present before the Court along with her counsel. The Investigating Officer present in the court has identified her. I have enquired from the complainant whether the

matter has been settled with the petitioners amicably without fear and pressure. She has informed that the matter has been settled without any fear or pressure and she has no objection to the quashing of the FIR. It is informed that pursuant to the settlement demand drafts bearing Nos.947221, dated 29.3.2017; and 947195 dated 27.3.2017 for the sum of ₹70,000/- and ₹1,80,000/- respectively drawn on Punjab National Bank have been handed over to the complainant today in the court. Divorce by mutual consent has been granted.

(3) The petition is supported by the affidavits of the parties. Settlement/Compromise deed dated 20.11.2013 signed by the parties before Mediation Centre, Tis Hazari Courts is on record.

(4) Since the complainant/Respondent No.2 has voluntarily settled the dispute with the petitioners, no useful purpose will be served to continue with the proceedings. In the interest of justice and to put an end to the litigation and to enable the parties to settle in life after divorce, FIR No.290/2013 under Sections 498-A/406/34 IPC registered at Police Station Burari and all the proceedings emanating therefrom are quashed.

(5) The petition is disposed of accordingly.
