1. Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.1037/2014 registered under Sections 354/354A/354B/509/323/506/34 IPC at PS Jahangirpuri. It is stated that the matter has been settled amicably with the complainant / respondents No.2 & 3 vide settlement agreement dated 27.08.2016.

2. Complainant / respondents No.2 & 3 are present in person and have been identified by the Investigating Officer. I have enquired from them if they have settled the dispute with the petitioner amicably without any fear or pressure. They have informed that all the disputes between the parties have been resolved amicably with their free consent and they have no objection to the quashing of the FIR in question.

3. The petition is supported by affidavits of the parties. Copy of settlement agreement dated 27.08.2016 has been placed on record. Since the dispute between the parties has been settled, no useful purpose will be served to continue with the proceedings. 4. The petitioner is directed to deposit ₹ 20,000/- as costs in the Prime Minister Relief Fund within two weeks. Registry shall ensure its compliance.
5. The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
