The petitioner has challenged the *ex parte* award dated 19th August, 2015 whereby compensation of Rs.50,000/- has been awarded to the respondent. Learned counsel for the respondent has no objection to the setting aside of the *ex parte* award and the petitioner being permitted to contest the claim on merits. Learned counsel for the respondent, however, submits that the Industrial Tribunal should be directed to expedite the hearing of the claim, to which learned counsel for the petitioner has no objection.

The *ex parte* award dated 19th August, 2015 is set aside and the case is remanded back to the Industrial Tribunal and the petitioner is permitted to contest the claim on merits.
