Present joint application has been filed under Order 23 Rule 3 read with Section 151 CPC. The same is duly signed by learned counsel for the plaintiff as well as by the parties to the litigation.

Present application is also supported by affidavits of constituted attorney of the plaintiff and the proprietors-defendants.

Learned counsel for the plaintiff has identified the defendants who are personally present in Court.

Learned counsel for the plaintiff and the defendants in person have carried out a typographical correction in the prayer clause of the present application after initialling the same.

Learned counsel for the plaintiff and the defendants states that the matter has been compromised in accordance with the terms mentioned in the present compromise application.

Both the learned counsel further assure and undertake to this Court that the parties shall comply with the Settlement terms mentioned in the aforesaid joint application.
