3. The petition is supported by affidavits of the parties. Since the dispute between the parties has been settled, no useful purpose will be served to continue with the proceedings. In the interest of justice and to enable the parties to settle in life after divorce, FIR No.158/2012 registered under Sections 498A/406 IPC at PS K.W.Camp / Model Town and all the proceedings arising therefrom are quashed.

4. The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
