ORDER

The instant petition has been filed by the petitioners seeking quashing of FIR No. 1068/2013 under Sections 308/341/34 IPC registered at Police Station-Shakarpur, Delhi, on the complaint of respondent No.2 and the proceedings pursuant thereto on the ground that a compromise/settlement has been arrived at between the parties.

Status report has been filed by the State as per which out of six cases, the petitioner No. 2 has been acquitted in five cases.

Heard.

Respondent No.2 is present in Court today and is identified by the Investigating Officer. He states that he has settled the matter with the petitioner with his own free will and choice without any threat, pressure and coercion. He further submits that he does not wish to pursue the abovementioned FIR and the proceedings pursuant thereto. The petitioners

have paid a sum of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Two Thousand Only) to the respondent No. 2/complainant today in Court towards the compensation.

Statements of the parties have been recorded separately.

In view of the fact that the parties have amicably resolved their differences voluntarily out of their own free will and without any coercion, pressure, and no useful purpose will be served in continuance of the proceedings. It would be in the interest of justice to quash the abovementioned FIR and the proceedings pursuant thereto. There is no legal impediment in quashing the FIR in question. Consequently, FIR No. 1068/2013 under Sections 308/341/34 IPC registered at Police Station-Shakarpur, Delhi, and proceedings pursuant thereto are hereby quashed.

The petition is disposed of.
