ORDER

1. The petitioner has filed this petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. for providing her protection against respondents No.5 to 11.
2. Respondent No.5 is the husband of the petitioner and respondents No.6 and 7 are the brothers of respondent No.5. Respondents No.8, 9 and 10 are the sisters-in-law. Respondent No.11 is the sister of the mother-in-law of the petitioner.
