1. The challenge in this writ petition is to the cancellation of the registration of the selling dealer, i.e., Respondent No.2 and the statutory C Forms issued.
2. The matter is covered in favour of the Petitioner by the decision of this Court in *Jain Manufacturing (India) Pvt. Ltd. v. The Commissioner Value Added Tax 2016 VII AD (Del) 139*. Learned counsel for the Respondents states that the Value Added Tax Officer has, being conscious of the above judgment, already recommended restoration of the C Forms. He assures the Court that the necessary orders will be passed in that regard not later than four weeks from today.

3. In that view of the matter, taking the assurance of learned counsel for the Respondents on record, the writ petition is disposed of. If there is any non-compliance with the above assurance, it will be open to the Petitioner to seek appropriate remedy in accordance with law.
