CRL.M.A.No.2789/2017 (Delay)

1. For the reasons mentioned in the application for condonation of delay in refiling the petition, the delay is condoned.

2. The application for condonation of delay is disposed of.

CRL.M.C. 650/2017 & CRL.M.A.No.2787/2017 (Stay)

1. Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.307/2010 registered under Section 324 IPC at PS Najafgarh. It is stated that the matter has been settled amicably with the complainant / respondent No.2 vide settlement deed dated 20.08.2015.

2. Complainant / respondent No.2 is present with counsel and has been identified by the Investigating Officer. I have enquired from the complainant if she has settled the dispute with the petitioner amicably without any fear or pressure. She has informed that all the disputes between the parties have been resolved amicably with her free consent and she has no objection to the quashing of the FIR in question. Divorce by mutual consent has already been granted in case FIR No.330/2010 registered under Sections 498A/34 IPC at PS Najafgarh and pursuant to the settlement, remaining amount of ₹1.5 lac by way of demand draft bearing No. 798834 dated 14.02.2017 drawn on Punjab National Bank has been given to the complainant in the Court today.

3. The petition is supported by affidavits of the parties. Copy of settlement deed dated 20.08.2015 has been placed on record. Cross case registered vide FIR No.31/2011 under Sections 323/342/506/34 IPC at PS Najafgarh has also been settled and the FIR therein has been quashed. Since the dispute between the parties has been settled, no useful purpose will be served to continue with the proceedings. In the interest of justice and to enable the parties to settle in life after divorce, FIR No.307/2010 registered under Section 324 IPC at PS Najafgarh and all the proceedings arising therefrom are quashed.

4. The petition stands disposed of accordingly. Pending application also stands disposed of.
