Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that no public witness has identified the knife allegedly recovered from the petitioner. Petitioner is in custody since 7<sup>th</sup> May, 2015.

Keeping in mind the totality of circumstances, petitioner is admitted to bail, subject to his furnishing a personal bond in the sum of ₹25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand Only) with one surety in the like amount to

the satisfaction of the trial court.

Bail application is disposed of in the above terms.
