The appellant is aggrieved by the interim order dated 07.04.2017 passed by the learned Principal Judge, Family Court, on an application moved by the respondent-wife under Section 24 and 26 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 seeking *pendente lite* maintenance for herself and for her son along with litigation expenses.
