ORDER

(1) Present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been preferred by the petitioners for quashing of FIR No.494/2013 under Sections 498-A/34 IPC registered at Police Station, Govind Puri. It is stated that the matter has been settled with the complainant/victim amicably before Mediation Centre, Saket Courts.

(2) Respondent No.2-complainant is present before the Court along with her counsel. The Investigating Officer present in the court has identified her. I have enquired from the complainant whether the matter has been settled with the petitioners amicably without fear and pressure. She has informed that the matter has been settled without any fear or pressure and she has no objection to the quashing of the FIR. It is informed that pursuant to the settlement Bankers' Cheque bearing Nos. 827794 dated 11th May, 2017 for the sum of ₹10,000/-

(Rupees Ten Thousnad Only) and 827995 dated 11th May,2017 for the sum of ₹25,000/-(Rupees Twenty Five Thousand Only), both drawn on State Bank of India, have been handed over to the complainant today in the court. Divorce by mutual consent has been granted.

(3) The petition is supported by the affidavits of the parties. Mediation agreement dated 8th September, 2014 held at Mediation Centre, Saket recording settlement between the parties is on record.

(4) Since the complainant/Respondent No.2 has voluntarily settled the dispute with the petitioners, no useful purpose will be served to continue with the proceedings. In the interest of justice and to put an end to the litigation and to enable the parties to settle in life after divorce, FIR No. 494/2013 under Sections 498-A/34 IPC registered at Police Station, Govind Puri and all the proceedings emanating therefrom are quashed.

(6) The petition is disposed of accordingly.
