This is an application under Section 438 Cr.P.C. filed on behalf of the petitioner for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.18053/2016, under Sections 419/420/468/471 IPC, registered at Police Station-Dwarka Sector-23, Delhi.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is an innocent person having no nexus with the FIR No.18053/2016, under Sections 419/420/468/471 IPC, registered at Police Station-Dwarka Sector-23, Delhi. Learned counsel further submits that the petitioner is apprehending his arrest in the above case. He further submits that the petitioner has already joined investigation and nothing is to be recovered at the instance of the petitioner. He submits that the petitioner is ready to join investigation in this case.

Learned APP for the State, on the other hand, vehemently opposes the

anticipatory bail application and has filed status report. Learned APP for State admits that the petitioner has joined investigation.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation and in the event of his arrest he be released on anticipatory bail in the sum of Rs.20,000/- with one surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of IO/SHO concerned with the condition that the petitioner shall not influence the prosecution witnesses; the petitioner shall not tamper the prosecution evidence and the petitioner should not leave India without prior permission of the Court below.

The present bail application is allowed and disposed of accordingly.
