**CrI. M.C. 2957/2017**

This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. moved by the petitioners for quashing of FIR No.367/2012, under Sections 323/452/34 IPC and Sections 27/25/(54)/59 Arms Act, registered at Police Station Dabri and all the subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that the petitioners and the complainant/respondent No.2 are residents of the nearby locality but due to some misunderstanding a quarrel had taken place between them, which resulted into registration of the aforesaid FIR. He also submits

that after the registration of FIR, the near relatives and close friends intervened and the matter has been amicably settled between them before the Mediation Centre, Dwarka Courts, New Delhi, which has been reduced down into writing on 22.02.2017 and that nothing remains to be adjudicated. He further submits that the present FIR is coming as a hurdle in the future life of the petitioners and respondent No.2 and prays that the present FIR may be quashed.

The respondent No.2 is present in person and has been identified by the Investigating Officer ASI Devender Kumar and admits that he has amicably resolved all disputes with the petitioners voluntarily without there being any threat, coercion or pressure of any sort. He further submits that he has no objection, if the present FIR is quashed.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances, since the matter has been amicably settled between the parties and nothing is to be adjudicated further, I deem it appropriate to quash the FIR in question. Consequently, to meet the ends of justice, the FIR No.367/2012, under Sections 323/452/34 IPC and Sections 27/25/(54)/59 Arms Act, registered at Police Station Dabri and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
