It would be in the interest of justice to quash the abovementioned FIR and the proceedings pursuant thereto. There is no legal impediment in quashing the FIR in question. Consequently, FIR No. 56/2014 registered under Section 498-A at PS Vivek Vihar, Delhi and proceedings pursuant thereto are hereby quashed.

The petition is disposed of.
