Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner no. 1 who is married to an Indian citizen i.e. petitioner no. 5, has given birth to a child on 27.06.2016 who is arrayed as petitioner no. 4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that since petitioner no. 4 is an Indian citizen, the petitioner being the mother of minor Indian child would also have the additional right of visitation and stay in the country. She submits that a representation would be made to the respondents for granting extension of Visa for further period of six months and also for an X-category Visa to enable the petitioner to visit Uzbekistan and also to take care of petitioner no. 4 in India.

Learned counsel for respondent submits that as and when such an application is made, the same shall be considered in accordance

with law.

The writ petition is disposed of directing the respondents to consider and dispose of the application of the petitioner within a period of two weeks from the receipt of the same in accordance with law. The petition is accordingly disposed of.
