This case has come on transfer as Hon'ble Mr. Justice Najmi Waziri is not available today.

The petitioner seeks bail in anticipation of his arrest in connection with the FIR No.454/16 dated 29.03.2016 (PS Vikas Puri) instituted for the offence under Sections 498A/406/34 IPC.

The petitioner is the husband of the complainant. It has been submitted that in the third round of mediation, the dispute has been settled and it has been agreed upon between the spouses that they would part ways amicably.

Considering this aspect of the matter, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.
