1. The learned counsel for the parties states that the parties have resolved their disputes and have entered into a Settlement Agreement dated 17.03.2017 before the Delhi High Court Mediation and Conciliation Centre (DHCMCC). The said Settlement Agreement has been placed on record. In terms of the said agreement, the defendant has agreed not to use the mark/logo/label "SLCC" or any other mark/logo/label with the suffix "LCC". However, the defendant is free to use the mark/logo/label "SCLC".
