1. These petitions under Section 24 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 (CPC) seeks transfer of (1). Civil Suit no. 78293/16 titled HDFC BANK LTD. VS. JAY TRADERS AND OTHERS; and (2). Suit No. 578292/16 titled “ HDFC BANK LTD. VS. ADARSH TRADING COMPANY AND ANOTHER” both pending in the Court of Sh.
