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(1) Present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been preferred by the petitioners for quashing of FIR No.107/2013 under Sections 308/34 IPC registered at Police Station Ghazipur. It is stated that the matter has been settled with the complainant/victims amicably on their behalf and on behalf of their son 'Haria' who is also one of the victims.

(2) Respondent Nos.2 and 3 are present before the Court and are

identified by the Investigating Officer. I have enquired from the complainant/victims whether the matter has been settled with the petitioners amicably without fear and pressure. They have informed that the matter has been settled without any fear or pressure and they have no objection to the quashing of the FIR. The parties are neighbours.

(3) The petition is supported by the affidavits of the parties. Settlement/Compromise deed dated 11.11.2016 signed by the parties is on record.

(4) Since the Respondent Nos.2 and 3 have voluntarily settled the dispute with the petitioners, no useful purpose will be served to continue with the proceedings. In the interest of justice and to put an end to the litigation and to enable the parties to maintain their neighbourly relations, FIR No.107/2013 under Sections 308/34 IPC registered at Police Station Ghazipur and all the proceedings emanating therefrom are quashed.

(5) The petitioners are, however, burdened with costs of ₹15,000/- to be deposited with Prime Minister National Relief Fund within two weeks. The Registry shall ensure the compliance of the order.

(6) The petition is disposed of accordingly.
