The instant petition has been filed by the petitioners seeking quashing of FIR No.439/2012 registered under Sections 308/325/341/379/506/34 IPC at P.S. Karawal Nagar, New Delhi, on the complaint of respondent No.2 and the proceedings pursuant thereto on the ground that a compromise/settlement has been arrived at between the parties in the matter.

Respondent Nos.2 and 3 are present in Court today and are identified by the Investigating Officer. They state that they have settled the matter with the petitioners with their own free will and choice without any threat,

pressure and coercion as per Settlement Deed /Compromise Deed dated 06.01.2017 and do not wish to pursue the abovementioned FIR and the proceedings pursuant thereto.

Statements of the parties have been recorded separately.

In view of the fact that the parties have amicably resolved their differences voluntarily and out of their own free will and without any coercion, pressure, and no useful purpose will be served in continuance of the proceedings. It would be in the interest of justice to quash the abovementioned FIR and the proceedings pursuant thereto. There is no legal impediment in quashing the FIR in question. Consequently, FIR No.439/2012 registered under Sections 308/325/341/379/506/34 IPC at P.S. Karawal Nagar, New Delhi and proceedings pursuant thereto are hereby quashed.

The petition is disposed of.
