Further time is sought on behalf of the respondents to file the status report. Ld. counsel for the respondents submits that the report is ready and shall be filed during the course of the day and that, the delay occurred for the reasons attributable to his office. In view of the reasons given for delay, the status report is taken on record, which is handed over in the Court.

As per the status report by way of an affidavit, the building plan has since been revoked and the construction has been treated to be unauthorised or illegal.
