The learned counsel for the parties at the Bar inform us that the petitioner Ms. Shruti Jindal has rejoined her husband at the matrimonial home, and that the latter has withdrawn the proceedings seeking divorce under the provisions of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955.

It is directed accordingly. In view of the foregoing, Mr. Jain, on instructions of Ms. Shruti Jindal, seeks leave to withdraw the petition at this stage. The petition and the pending applications, are accordingly, disposed off. However, in the event of any difficulty, the petitioner is free to revive the petition by way of an appropriate application.
