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After some hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to approach the Court in case the date for election is fixed and the petitioner is not permitted to submit his nomination form notwithstanding the fact that he has filed a revision petition against the debarment order passed by the Returning Officer before the Financial Commissioner.
