In view of the status report dated 22.08.2017 of the respondent-2/SDM, Kapashera and the status report dated 28.08.2017 filed on behalf of respondent-SDM. Ld. counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the writ petition with the liberty to approach the concerned revenue authority for seeking demarcation of his land and restoration of possession.
