1. For the reasons mentioned in the application for condonation of delay in refiling the petition, the delay is condoned.
2. The application for condonation of delay is disposed of.

CRL.M.C. 388/2017

1. Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.5/2014 registered under Sections 323/341/377/406/498 IPC at PS Sector-23 Dwarka. It is stated that the matter has been settled amicably with the complainant / respondent No.2 before the Counseling Cell, Family Courts, Dwarka

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Court, New Delhi vide settlement agreement dated 23.01.2014.

2. Complainant / respondent No.2 is present with counsel and has been identified by the Investigating Officer. I have enquired from the complainant if she has settled the dispute with the petitioners amicably without any fear or pressure. She has informed that all the disputes between the parties have been resolved amicably with her free consent and she has no objection to the quashing of the FIR in question. Divorce by mutual consent has already been granted. Pursuant to the settlement, remaining amount of ₹1 lac by way of demand draft bearing No.536000 dated 30.01.2017 drawn on Syndicate Bank has been given to the complainant in the Court today. Copy of which has been placed on record.

3. The petition is supported by affidavits of the parties. Copy of settlement agreement dated 23.01.2014 has been placed on record. Since the dispute between the parties has been settled, no useful purpose will be served to continue with the proceedings. In the interest of justice and to enable the parties to settle in life after divorce, FIR No.5/2014 registered under Sections 323/341/377/406/498 IPC at PS Sector-23 Dwarka and all the proceedings arising therefrom are quashed.

4. The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
