1. The petitioners seek anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C.

BAIL APPLN. 2688/2016 & connected matters

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in case FIR No.616/2016 registered under Sections 420/34 IPC at PS Hari Nagar. Status report is on record.

2. I have heard the learned counsel for the parties including the father of the complainant (Mr. Jayant Kumar) and have examined the file. By an order dated 03.01.2017, the petitioners were granted interim protection and were directed to join the investigation as and when required. Undisputedly, the petitioners have joined the investigation since then.

3. Vide order dated 03.01.2017, the petitioners were directed to pay ₹7 lacs to the complainant without prejudice and subject to future adjustment (if any). Complainant's father informed that in compliance of the said order the amount of ₹7 lacs has been received. He has no objection to the confirmation of the bail.

4. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the petitioners are granted anticipatory bail and in the event of arrest, they be released on furnishing personal bond in the sum of ₹ 50,000/- with one surety each in the like amount to the satisfaction of the SHO/Investigating officer. They shall, however, join the investigation as and when required.

5. The bail applications stand disposed of. Pending applications also stand disposed of.
