Application stands disposed of.

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The instant petition has been filed by the petitioners seeking quashing of FIR No. 237/2016 under Sections 498A/406/34 IPC registered at Police Station-New Ashok Nagar, Delhi, on the complaint of respondent No.2 and the proceedings pursuant thereto on the ground that a compromise/settlement has been arrived at between the parties on 29.07.2016 before the Mediation Centre, Karkardooma Courts, Delhi, Delhi.

Respondent No.2 is present in Court today and is identified by the Investigating Officer. She states that she has settled the matter with the petitioners with her own free will and choice without any threat, pressure

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and coercion. She further submits that she has settled her dispute with petitioners as per the terms and conditions recorded on 29.07.2017 before the Mediation Centre, Karkardooma Courts, Delhi and she has already received Rs.3,00,000/- (Rupees Three Lacs Only) from the petitioners and today she has been paid Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees One Lac only) in cash by the petitioners. She submits that she does not wish to pursue the abovementioned FIR and the proceedings pursuant thereto.

Statements of the parties have been recorded separately.

In view of the fact that the parties have amicably resolved their differences voluntarily out of their own free will and without any coercion, pressure, and no useful purpose will be served in continuance of the proceedings. It would be in the interest of justice to quash the abovementioned FIR and the proceedings pursuant thereto. There is no legal impediment in quashing the FIR in question. Consequently, FIR No. 237/2016 under Sections 498//406/34 IPC registered at Police Station-New Ashok Nagar, Delhi, and proceedings pursuant thereto are hereby quashed.

The petition is disposed of.
