1. Present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been preferred to challenge the legality and correctness of an order dated 24.07.2015 in case FIR No.447/2015 registered under Sections 498A/377/354/506/34 IPC at PS Jagat Puri by which interim protection to the petitioner was not given.

2. During the course of arguments it was informed that the matter has been settled between the parties. Complainant has informed that first motion has since been granted. She has no objection to the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

3. Since the matter has been settled and the terms and conditions of the settlement are being acted upon, the petitioners are granted anticipatory bail and in the event arrest, they be released on furnishing personal bond in the sum of ₹ 50,000/- with one surety each in the

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like amount to the satisfaction of the SHO/Investigating officer. They shall, however, join the investigation as and when required
