Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the parties, state in unison, that the underlying dispute that led to the institution of the present company petition has been amicably settled by and between the parties with the aid and assistance of Delhi High Court Mediation and Conciliation Centre and the terms and conditions of the settlement are enshrined in the Settlement Agreement dated 16.2.2017.
