In view of the foregoing, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner seeks leave to withdraw this petition with liberty to revive the same in

the event the respondent company resiles from the abovesaid statement.

Leave and liberty granted.

The petition is dismissed as withdrawn and disposed of accordingly.
