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1. By this writ petition, the petitioner seeks directions to the respondents to control the rate of operation charges, Doctor visiting charges, Nursing charges and room charges and to fix a policy for controlling the rate of all types of charges which are being charged by hospitals during the treatment and related matters.

2. It appears that the representations made by the petitioner in this regard have not been considered by the respondents.

3. We, therefore, dispose of this petition with a direction to the respondent No.1- Union of India, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Nirman Bhawan, New Delhi as well as the Secretary, Department of Health and Family Welfare, Govt. of NCT of Delhi,
