Learned APP does not dispute that the role of petitioner has surfaced only in the disclosure statement of co-accused Azam, who has

already been granted bail. Keeping in mind totality of the circumstances, petitioner is admitted to bail subject to his furnishing a personal bond in the sum of ₹10,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial court.
