6. Accordingly, Mr.Jagmohan Lal (Mobile No.9891426576), R/o 121, Ankur Apartments, 7, IP Extension Delhi- 110092 is appointed as the sole arbitrator to adjudicate the dispute between the parties. A copy of this order be sent to the learned arbitrator.
