The application stands disposed of.

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The instant petition has been filed by the petitioners seeking quashing of FIR No.50/2011 for the offences punishable under Sections 498A/406/34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at police station-Khyala, Delhi on the complaint of respondent No.2 and the proceedings pursuant thereto on the ground that a compromise/settlement has been arrived at between the parties in the matter.

Respondent No. 2 is present in Court today and is identified by the the Investigating Officer. She states that she has settled the matter with the

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petitioner in terms of Delhi Mediation Centre order dated 19.12.2015. As per terms of Delhi Mediation Centre order dated 19.12.2015, the petitioners were required to pay a sum of ₹1,00,000/- (Rupees One Lakh only) to the respondent No. 2 at the time of quashing the FIR. She states that she has received the said amount today through a Banker Cheque and has no claim whatsoever remaining against the petitioner and does not wish to pursue the abovementioned FIR and the proceedings pursuant thereto. Statements of the parties have been recorded separately.

In view of the fact that the parties have amicably resolved their differences voluntarily and of their own free will and without any coercion, pressure, and no useful purpose will be served in continuance of the proceedings, rather the same would create further acrimony between them, it would be in the interest of justice to quash the abovementioned FIR and the proceedings pursuant thereto. There is no legal impediment in quashing the FIR in question. Consequently, FIR No.50/2011 for the offences punishable under Sections 498A/406/34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at police station-Khyala, Delhi and proceedings pursuant thereto are hereby quashed.

The petition is disposed of.
