The petitioners have filed the present petitions, *inter alia*, impugning the action of respondents in withholding the renewal of their registrations. This, it is contended, amounts to blacklisting. It is also pointed out that no show cause notice for withholding of any registration has been issued.

The learned counsel appearing for the respondents submits that the renewal of registration shall not be withheld for a period of more than four weeks from today. In the meanwhile, if the respondents seek to deny renewal of registration, respondents shall issue a show cause notice and give full opportunity to the petitioners to represent their case and pass a final order within the period of four weeks.

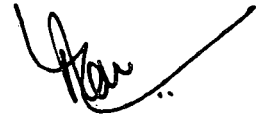
