Pursuant to the order dated 30.10.2017, on which date learned counsel for the petitioner has stated that the petitioner is willing to confine his relief in the present petition to the request made to the respondent for permission to retain the family quarter allotted to him at Jyoti Kunj Complex, Dwarka till the end of the academic year of his two sons, i.e., till the end of 31st March, 2018, learned counsel for the respondents states that he has obtained necessary instructions. He hands over a copy of the order dated 02.11.2017 issued by the DIG (Admn.), CRPF permitting the petitioner to retain the family quarters in question till 31.03.2018.
