ORDER

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The instant petition has been filed by the petitioners seeking quashing of FIR No.234/2015 for the offences punishable under Sections 308/506/34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 (in short 'IPC'), registered at PS-Sonia Vihar, Delhi on the complaint of respondent No.2 and the proceedings pursuant thereto on the ground that a compromise/settlement dated 24.10.2017 has been arrived at between the parties in the matter.

Respondent No.2 is present in Court today and is identified by counsel and the Investigating Officer. She states that she has settled the matter with the petitioners of free will and choice without any threat, pressure and coercion, as per terms and conditions of the MOU/Compromise Deed dated 24.10.2017.

Statements of the parties have been recorded separately.

In view of the fact that the parties have amicably resolved their differences voluntarily and of their own free will and without any coercion, pressure, and no useful purpose will be served in continuance of the proceedings. It would be in the interest of justice to quash the abovementioned FIR and the proceedings pursuant thereto. There is no legal impediment in quashing the FIR. Consequently, FIR No.234/2015 for the offences punishable under Sections 308/506/34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 (in short 'IPC'), registered at PS-Sonia Vihar, Delhi and proceedings pursuant thereto are hereby quashed.

The petition alongwith pending application is disposed of.
