ORDER

The instant petition has been filed by the petitioners seeking quashing of FIR No.555/2013, under Sections 498-A/406/34 IPC registered at Police Station-Sunlight Colony, New Delhi on the complaint of respondent No.2 and the proceedings pursuant thereto on the ground that the parties have amicably settled their disputes as per Settlement/Mediation Centre order dated 07.11.2016.

Respondent No.3 is present in Court today and is identified by the Investigating Officer. She states that she has settled the matter with the petitioners with her own free will and choice without any threat, pressure and coercion as per Settlement/Mediation Centre order dated 07.11.2016 and she does not wish to pursue the abovementioned FIR and the proceedings pursuant thereto. She further submits that today she has received a sum of Rs.2,00,000/- (Rupees Two Lakh only) through a Demand Draft No.007843

dated 02.11.2017, drawn on Punjab National Bank, Rana Pratap Bagh, Delhi branch, from the petitioners before the Court.

Statements of the parties have been recorded separately.

In view of the fact that the parties have amicably resolved their differences voluntarily out of their own free will and without any coercion, pressure, and no useful purpose will be served in continuance of the proceedings. It would be in the interest of justice to quash the abovementioned FIR and the proceedings pursuant thereto. There is no legal impediment in quashing the FIR in question. Consequently, FIR No.555/2013, under Sections 498-A/406/34 IPC registered at Police Station-Sunlight Colony, New Delhi and all the proceedings pursuant thereto are hereby quashed.

The petition is disposed of.
