ORDER

Respondent no. 2 Gavneet Kaur is present in Court along with her counsel and has been identified by SI Praveen of police station Jagatpuri. Respondent no. 2 admits having settled the matter with petitioner no. 1 of her own free will, voluntarily and without any undue force, pressure or coercion. Respondent no. 2 submits that her marriage with the petitioner no.1 has already been dissolved by a decree of divorce by mutual consent dated 16th March, 2017 passed by the Family Court, Shahdara District, Karkardooma Courts, Delhi. Respondent no. 2 says that she has received the entire settled amount and she is not willing to pursue the FIR any further against the petitioner no. 1

and his relatives, that is, petitioner nos. 2 to 4 and the same may be quashed.

Keeping in mind the facts and circumstances as detailed above, more particularly, the fact that marriage of petitioner no. 1 and respondent no. 2 has already been dissolved by a decree of divorce by mutual consent, in the interest of justice, FIR No.239/2015 under Sections 498-A/406/34 IPC registered at Police Station Jagat Puri and the consequent proceedings emanating therefrom are quashed.

Petition is disposed of in the above terms. Dasti.
