Instant petition has come to be filed seeking issuance of a writ of certiorari with the prayer, as follows :

“(a) To issue appropriate writ, order or directions to quash the Bill No. 010006870851 for C.A. No. 60004596999 issued for premises No. 89/10, Onkar Nagar-B, Tri Nagar, Delhi.
