1. By way of this petition filed under Article 226 & 227 of the Constitution of India, read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. the petitioner is seeking parole for a period of three months.
2. Notice. Learned ASC as above accepts notice on behalf of the State.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner seeks parole for a period of three months as he wants to remain present at the time of distribution of ancestral property and to re-establish social ties with the family members and the society.
