ORDER

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26.04.2017

1. Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.24/2013 registered under Sections 147/148/149/308 IPC at PS Maurice Nagar. It is stated that the matter has been settled amicably with the complainant / victims.

2. Learned APP, on instructions, informs that there are seven assailants against whom charge-sheet has been filed. There are only four victims / injured who are the respondents No.2 to 5 in the present petition and all of them are present in the Court.

3. I have examined the Trial Court record. Only one formal witness has so far been examined. Statements of material prosecution witnesses have yet not been recorded. No effective progress has been

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made so far in the suit. The petitioners and the victims were students at the relevant time when the incident occurred. Injuries on the victims were 'simple' in nature.

4. Complainant / victims are present in person and have been identified by the Investigating Officer. I have enquired from them if they have settled the dispute with the petitioners amicably without any fear or pressure. They have informed that all the disputes between the parties have been resolved amicably with their free consent and they have no objection to the quashing of the FIR in question.

5. The petition is supported by affidavits of the parties. Since the dispute between the parties has been settled, no useful purpose will be served to continue with the proceedings. In the interest of justice and to enable the parties to put an end to the litigation, FIR No.24/2013 registered under Sections 147/148/149/308 IPC at PS Maurice Nagar and all the proceedings arising therefrom are quashed.

6. The petitioners are directed to deposit ₹ 20,000/- as costs in the Prime Minister Relief Fund within two weeks. Registry shall ensure its compliance.

7. The petition stands disposed of accordingly. Pending application also stands disposed of.
