1. Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner we find no merit in the petition. Apart from the reasons given by the Tribunal it was also the duty of the petitioner to have informed the Department that while issuing the revised PPO commuted part of the pension was not taken note of and the result was that apart from taking the benefit of the commuted pension the petitioner received full pension. We also note that the petitioner had given an undertaking that if any discrepancy was found in the PPO recovery could be made.
